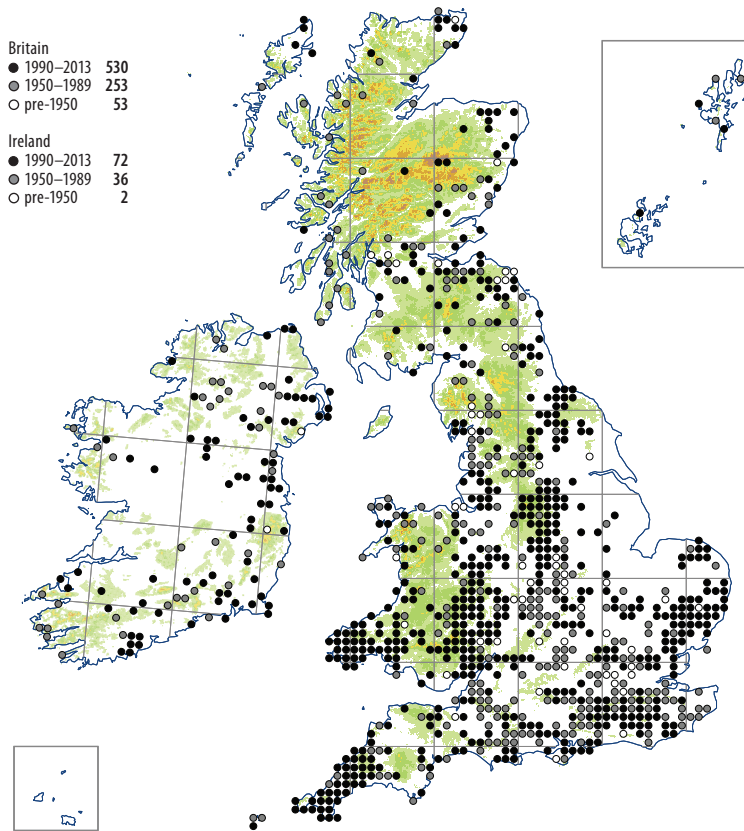
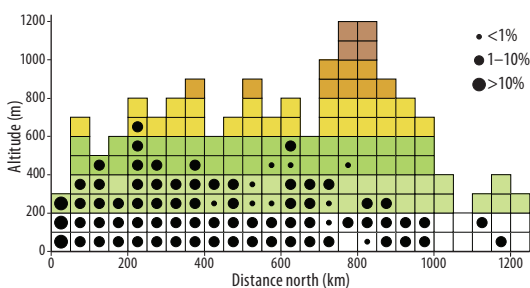


Ephemerum serratum s.l.



This map shows all records of *Ephemerum serratum* s.l., *E. serratum* s.s., *E. stellatum* and *E. minutissimum*. *E. stellatum* has been treated as a separate species in the past but is now regarded as a form of *E. serratum*. The segregates *E. minutissimum* and *E. serratum* s.s. are less well recorded than the aggregate. They have not always been clearly

separated and have often been treated as varieties. Risse (1996) and Holyoak (2010b) argue for their treatment as distinct species, as genuine intermediates do not occur. They are therefore mapped individually and their habitats described accordingly.
